

Android Device Onboarding Instructions

Note: Before connecting your Android device to the FISD BYOD network, please check the following:

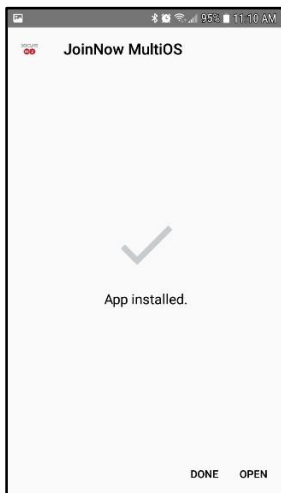
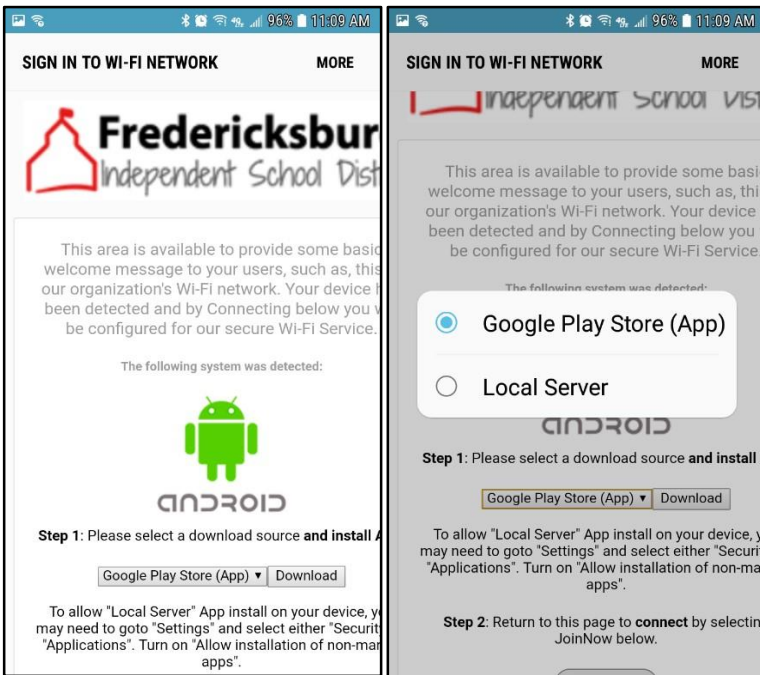
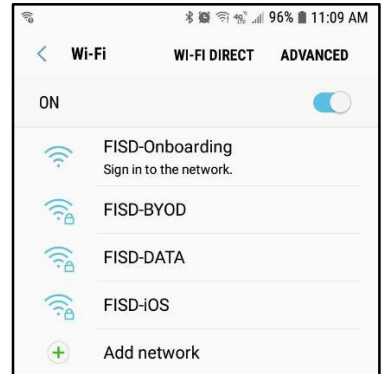
Is this an Android laptop? Make sure you do not have a pop-up blocker enabled.

Did you have the device on BYOD last year?

- If so, navigate to known networks. Go to Settings -> Connections -> Wi-Fi.
- Hold down on the FISD-BYOD network option. Select Forget Network from the list.
- Repeat for FISD-Onboarding if it is listed.

For FISD guests (non-district employee), use the guest credentials provided by your campus or department secretary.

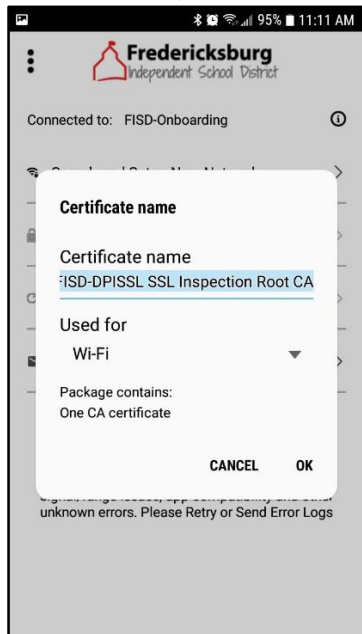
1. In the list of available Wi-Fi connections, select FISD-Onboarding.
2. FISD-Onboarding will redirect you to this page. From the dropdown menu, select Local Server.



3. Your browser will download and ask you to install the application. Click Install.
4. If this screen appears, select Open

5. After being redirected to the application, you will be asked to install a certificate. Under “Used for”, select “WiFi”, then select “Okay”. You might be asked for your phone passcode to install.



6. When prompted, enter your FISD computer credentials.
 - a. Ex. Username: johnd Password: Password123
 - b. For guests to FISD, use the guest credentials.
7. Then select Continue.
8. After successfully entering your credentials, select Done.
9. Open your list of Wi-Fi connects. Hold down on FISD-Onboard and select Forget this Network.
