### Minutes:

- Welcome
- Brandyn Quay read the September minutes. Approved September, 2018 minutes.
- Kim Wilson proposed not to do the *Play It Safe* curriculum because it is already taking place on campus. Dr. Styles will communicate with the *Play It Safe* representative about the decision not to use the curriculum. Motion Passed.
- Shea Nebgen discussed *Walk Across Texas* which is an agency to educate the public about health issues. Mrs. Nebgen said the registration process is changing for FISSD. There is a video on how to sign up and individuals put their own information in. Mrs. Nebgen also said she will share the *State of Health* form with employees. –Julie Sifford, Patricia Smith, Jennifer Mcbee-Donnie Finn will be *Walk Across Texas* representatives.
- Officer Shane Purvis discussed the presentation he gives to 8<sup>th</sup> graders on vaping each year. There was a lot of discussion about vaping. The committee discussed the suppliers of vaping products and what laws can be enforced on businesses, parents and students when vapes are brought on campus. Nurse Mayo is going to make contact with a doctor and schedule times for the doctor to talk to students about the health risks of vaping. Dr. Cornett made the point that smoking and vaping together doubles the chance of developing cancer. Mrs. Nebgen said Blanco ISD pays for *the Catch Your Breath* curriculum through a grant. Officer Purvis proposed the idea of using previous discipline against students when assigning charges for vaping. Officer Shane said the probation officer, Ron Sutton, is willing to do 6-month educational program for students in possession of vapes on campus.
- Wanda Detmar presented the many things she does as FISSD Parent Liaison.
- Mr. Kirchner mentioned the suicide prevention group that was started at the H.S. Officer Ayala has held several meetings at the H.S. campus and the turnout has been an average of 6 students per meeting. The need for advertising a suicide hotline was proposed by Mrs. Nebgen.
